- Assure the review of Quality Management Systems at contract manufacturers to ensure that products meet all quality standards
- Responsible for following the 3PMs audit procedure, review and follow up on audit reports
- Negotiation and pricing discussions on technical and commercial agreements with CMOs
- Define and monitor targets regarding budget, costs, yield, services and quality
- Preparation and approval of annual reports for the entity
- Provide reporting and yearly evaluation of performance against targets, analyze deviations and set up of corrective and preventive measures
