

Supply Chain Specialist, BioCare Copenhagen

As Supply Chain Specialist you will be a liaison between suppliers of raw materials, production and packaging facilities and customers. You will join the local team of 6 highly skilled and motivated colleagues, and have close contact to colleagues, customers, suppliers and other partners world-wide, you therefore have to be flexible regarding working across time zones. The team is located in the Danish Royal DSM Office in Broendby, Greater Copenhagen, and you will report to the Business Operations Director.

The Challenge

As Supply Chain Specialist you will be responsible for the establishment of the supply chain setup, for master data, and operational launch of branded products in target markets. The key tasks involve the operational handling from introduction of new formulations to delivery of the final products to partners globally. You will work on challenging projects, new market entries, and agile supply chain setups, as well as daily order handling for branded goods and upcoming product launches.

Your primary tasks will include, but not be limited to:

- Local project leadership on operational tasks of product launches for branded goods
- Support of project team in ERP set-up and master data verification and handling
- Handling of day-to-day orders in a newly established portfolio
- Purchasing and invoice handling
- Collaborating on forecasting and stock keeping of raw materials
- Artwork coordination between marketing departments and the packing site
- Resolution of distributer and stakeholder challenges to maximize end customer satisfaction
- Establishing and monitoring of key performance indicators of portfolio operations
